PROJECT DESCRIPTION	
A draft environmental impact report (EIR) has been prepared by the San Francisco Planning Department in connection with this project. The project site is currently developed with a two-story approximately 29-foot-tall wood-frame building constructed in approximately 1922. The existing building most recently housed the Metropolitan Community Church (MCC) of San Francisco and is currently vacant. The building is considered to be individually eligible for listing on the California Register of Historic Resources due to its association with the City's LGBTQ community.	
The proposed project would result in the demolition of the existing building and construction of two four-story buildings with two residential units in each building, for a total of four residential units. The two buildings would total approximately 13,174 gross square feet (gsf) in size, and each would include a four-car garage and indoor common areas. The proposed buildings would not exceed 40 feet in height.	
<b>DRAFT EIR:</b> The draft EIR finds that implementation of the proposed project would lead to significant unavoidable project-level impacts related to historic architectural resources. The draft EIR, including a detailed project description, is available for public review and comment on the planning department's website at <a href="http://www.sf-planning.org/sfceqadocs">http://www.sf-planning.org/sfceqadocs</a> .	
The purpose of the public hearing is for the planning commission and department staff to receive comments on the adequacy of the EIR. The planning commission will not respond to any of the comments or take action on the project at this hearing. Public comments on the draft EIR will be accepted from December 6, 2017 to 5:00 p.m. on January 23, 2018. The comment period for this draft EIR will be 49 days.
