

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Holloway Green Street project would implement green infrastructure for stormwater management along nine blocks of Holloway Avenue starting at Ashton Avenue and extending just past Lee Avenue in the Ingleside neighborhood. The project would improve the residential street into a greener, more pedestrian- and bike-friendly corridor by incorporating multi-functional green infrastructure technologies. Corner bulbouts containing bioretention planters would provide traffic calming and improve pedestrian safety while removing stormwater from the combined sewer system. An implementation project of the SFPUC's Sewer System Improvement Program, the proposed project is planned to relieve the City's aging sewer system by reducing stormwater runoff while providing various community benefits.

DETERMINATION:

A CEQA determination was issued March 6, 2015 under Planning Department Case Number 2015.002821ENV. Therefore no further environmental review would be required for the proposed project. The project was approved by the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission on May 26, 2015.
