PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Washington Square (2.26-acre city park) is located on an irregular shaped block bounded by Columbus Avenue, Filbert, Stockton, Union, and Powell Streets in the North Beach neighborhood of San Francisco. Washington Square was locally designated as San Francisco Landmark No. 226 under Article 10 of the Planning Code in 1999. The project scope of work includes installation of a new weather sensing irrigation system, replacement of the existing sub-lawn drain infrastructure to reduce saturated soil conditions, replanting new draught tolerant landscaping, pathway repaving and ADA improvements, removal/replacement of 11 trees, and maintenance to existing benches.

DETERMINATION:

The City and County of San Francisco decided to carry out or approve the project on November 13, 2018 when the Board of Supervisors affirmed the determination by the Planning Department that the proposed project is categorically exempt from environmental review under BOS Motion No. M18-156. The Recreation and Park Commission approved the project on August 15, 2018, which was a duly noticed

public hearing at a regular scheduled meeting. See Recreation and Parks Commission Resolution No. 1808-008. The Recreation and Parks Department will carry out the project.
