PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The project sponsor proposes to alter the existing Presidio Knolls School campus in order to expand instruction to fourth- through eighth-grade students. The proposed project would demolish the elementary school building (Lot 038), preschool building (Lot 037), and garage (Lot 036); merge Lots 036, 037, and 038; construct two new school buildings; and make interior and exterior alterations to the rectory (Lot 034) and convert the space from group housing to educational uses. No interior or exterior alterations are proposed for the parish hall (Lot 037) which serves as a multi-purpose room. The proposed improvements would create an approximately 81,600-gsf school campus that could accommodate an additional 295 students (274 elementary and middle school students and 21preschool students) and 45 faculty/staff, resulting in a maximum enrollment of 550 students supported by 117 faculty/staff.

DETERMINATION:

The City and County of San Francisco decided to carry out or approve the project 250 10th Street on June 30, 2016 when the Planning Commission approved a Conditional Use Authorization and Large Project Authorization, pursuant to Planning Code Sections 303 and 304, and exceptions from Planning Code requirements, pursuant to Planning Code Sections 134, 145.1, 155.2, and 155.4, for this project.
