Project Location: 570 West 10th Street, west of Enterprise Circle, Pittsburg, Contra Costa County, California

Project Description: The project consists of the installation of three emergency generators at an existing Converter Station located at 570 West 10th Street in Pittsburg. Subject to approval of the city of San Francisco, three similar emergency generators would be installed at a second location in San Francisco at 435 23rd Street.

The purpose of the installation is to provide back-up power to the Converter Stations in the event of a power loss. The project also includes a Quick Start component. The Quick Start upgrade to the existing computerized operating systems is currently underway. The project includes the testing of the system once the software upgrade to the existing San Francisco Converter Station is complete.

This is to advise that the <u>City of Pittsburg</u> as <u>Lead Agency</u> approved the above-described project located in Pittsburg on <u>April 22, 2014,</u> and made the following determinations regarding the project:

- 1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- An Addendum to the 2006 Trans Bay Cable Project Environmental Impact Report (EIR) has been adopted for this project pursuant to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
- Mitigation measures were made conditions of the approval of the project.
- 4. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for this project.
- Findings were made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 6. A copy of the 2006 Trans Bay Cable Project EIR, EIR Addendum and Initial Study and record of project approval is available to the general public at the City of Pittsburg Planning Department, located at 65 Civic Avenue, Pittsburg, CA.
