PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The Baker Beach Green Street project would implement green infrastructure for stormwater management along El Camino Del Mar and Sea Cliff Avenue. The project would install four green infrastructure nodes adjacent to four pedestrian crossings on El Camino Del Mar, from the Legion of Honor to the Land's End trail head. The project would also install permeable pavement on Sea Cliff Avenue between 25th and 26th Avenues. In addition, three bio-retention bulbouts would be constructed at the corners of Sea Cliff Avenue and 25th and 26th Avenues. The project is part of the SFPUC's Sewer System Improvement Program (SSIP) which aims to upgrade San Francisco's aging sewer system over a 20-year period.
