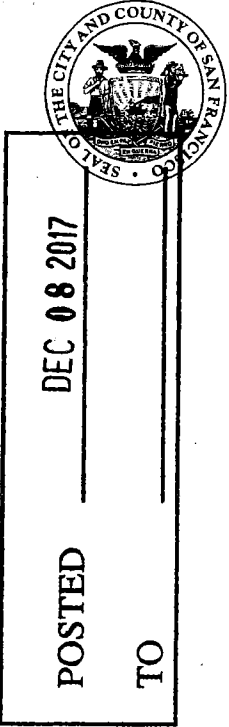

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Guidelines of the Secretary for Resources, and San Francisco requirements, this Notice of Exemption is transmitted to you for filing. PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) proposes to implement minor modifications to the existing public right of way on Bayshore Boulevard (between Jerrold Avenue and Marin Street), Jerrold Avenue (between Bayshore Boulevard and Barneveld Avenue), and on Barnveld Avenue (between McKinnon Avenue and Jerrold Avenue) in San Francisco. The project would include minor modifications to existing travel lanes to create a new bicycle lane on Jerrold Avenue. In addition, the project would include installation of new high visibility crosswalks at the intersection of Marin Street/Bayshore Boulevard and Jerrold Avenue/Bayshore Boulevard, the removal of 10 parking spaces and two loading zones along westbound Jerrold Avenue and establishment of parking restrictions on Barnveld Avenue. Overall, the project would not involve the construction of any permanent structures and consists mostly of paint and the installation of the soft-hit posts. No existing travel lanes would be removed as part of the project.

No excavation is required. Project construction, which includes painting and installation of soft hit posts, is anticipated to last approximately 15 days. The project is intended to make key portions of the Hairball Intersection area safer and easier to use for all modes of travel by making pedestrian and bicycle safety improvements.


DETERMINATION:

The City and County of San Francisco decided to carry out or approve the project on September 19, 2017. The project was subject to internal review by SFMTA staff, a recommendation for approval by the Transportation Advisory Staff Committee, Public Hearing with an SFMTA Hearing Officer, and finally approval by the SFMTA Board of Directors (the "SFMTA Board"), which was a duly noticed public hearing at a regularly scheduled meeting. See SFMTA Board Resolution No.1170910-119. SFMTA will carry out the project.
